

**Alberta Golf  
Discretionary Exemptions Criteria**

In order to be considered for a Discretionary Exemption individuals will be compared against the following criteria. A request for an exemption must be in writing and received by Alberta Golf by the event closing date. Special consideration for late submissions should be given in the case of medical emergencies.

| 1. Player will have demonstrated the ability to be competitive over the past three years:   | ( 1 )         |
| a. In the event for which requesting exemption:<br>(Results in similar provincial or state association tournaments will be given equal consideration) |               |
| Finish in a given year:   |               |
| Top 10 finish   | 5 points      |
| Made cut  | 4 points      |
| b. Other events   |               |
| Top 3 finish only   | 1 point       |
| (to a maximum of 3 points)  |               |
| Total score of a + b must be 10 or greater to receive the point for selection criteria #1 and move on to criteria 2-4.                                |               |
| 2. Addition of player to event would cause enhanced, positive publicity;  | ( 1 )         |
| 3. Selection of player would legitimize Alberta Golf's image;   | ( 1 )         |
| 4. Player has contributed toward the betterment of golf through:  | ( 1 )         |
