This individual is an applicant for an A.G.A.F. scholarship. The Scholarship Committee will be grateful if you will provide a frank statement regarding this applicant's qualifications. The contents of your letter of reference will be held strictly confidential. Replies must be received by the A.G.A.F. by July 31 to complete the student's scholarship application.

Proven academic qualities are required of applicants, but they will also be required to show integrity of character, school and community involvement and solid citizenship.

It is not expected that you will be able to speak from first hand knowledge of the candidate's qualifications under all those heads. If you are primarily acquainted with the candidate through an academic relationship you are requested to concentrate particularly on intellectual quality and potential - although your assessment of the other qualities will be very welcome. If, on the other hand, you are better acquainted with the candidate through non-academic interests, you are requested to concentrate on assessment of character in the knowledge that the Committee is looking for persons who are deserving individuals and who will be good representatives of Alberta and Alberta Golf.

Please do not hesitate to speak of the candidate's limitations as well as qualities. A critical appraisal will add to, rather than detract from, the force of your letter, since Committee's tend to be dubious of recommendations which imply that a candidate has no limitations whatever .

### Scholarship Opportunities

#### Bill Sturgeon Memorial Scholarship

The scholarship was created in memory of Bill Sturgeon, a dedicated volunteer and ambassador of the game. This annual \$1000.00 scholarship is awarded to an Alberta resident pursuing a post secondary education.

#### Charles C. Reid Scholarship

Each year 10 scholarships of \$1,000.00 are awarded to students pursuing Golf Management and Turfgrass Management Degrees. This program is funded by the Estate of Charles C. Reid, formerly an enthusiastic patron of golf from Banff.

#### Christa Spahmann Memorial Scholarship

The Scholarship was created in the memory of Christa Spahmann, a fun loving, hardworking extremely good athlete. The recipient of the scholarship will display these qualities.

#### Frank Lindsay Memorial Scholarship

The Scholarship was created in the memory of Frank Lindsay, a well known and respected amateur golfer from Calgary. This annual \$1000.00 scholarship is awarded to an Alberta resident pursuing a post secondary education.

#### Lola Rozsa Scholarship

The annual Lola Rozsa scholarship of \$1,000 will be awarded to a 23 year old or younger Alberta Student. Lola is a past president of the Alberta Ladies' Golf Association and continues to be a prominent supporter of city and provincial ladies initiatives.

#### McLennan Ross Sun Junior Tour Scholarships

Annual scholarships of \$1,000.00 are awarded to Alberta students. The McLennan Ross Sun Junior Tour is now in its twelfth season providing junior golfers in Alberta the opportunity to develop their game.

#### Mike Bower Memorial Scholarship

Mike Bower started playing the game of golf at age 11 and by the conclusion of his junior career would capture two consecutive Alberta Junior Championships. Beyond being a good player, Mike also volunteered his time to making golf a better game for juniors and fellow golfers. The two annual \$1,000.00 scholarships, awarded to male and female students under the age of 25, are a legacy to a gentleman who had a passion for life and the game of golf.

#### R.E. Courage Memorial Scholarship

The R.E. Courage Memorial Scholarship was created in the memory of Dick Courage of Calgary. Always a favorite coach in minor sports, Dick was well known for his ability to inspire and motivate his young players. This annual \$1,000.00 scholarship is awarded to an Alberta student.

#### Sun Life Financial Scholarship

Sun Life Financial is a long time sponsor of the Alberta Men's and Women's Amateur Golf Championships. This annual \$1,000.00 scholarship is awarded to an Albertan Resident pursuing a post-secondary education.

## Scholarship Criteria

Scholarship applications will be judged on the following criteria if applicable:

1. Academic performance in the previous school year.
2. Financial need.
3. Participation in extracurricular or community activities.
4. Relevant work experience.
  - Due to NCAA Bylaws, preference will be given to applicants who enroll in a recognized Canadian post secondary institution.

## Scholarship Policies

1. Scholarships may be renewable annually, up to a maximum of four years. Recipients must reapply each year and continue to meet the established scholarship criteria.
2. All awards are contingent upon the applicant being accepted by and remaining enrolled at the University or College of his/her choice on a full time, full year academic basis.
3. Only completed applications disclosing full details as requested will be considered.
- 4. This scholarship program is available to all Albertans pursuing post-secondary education.**
5. Scholarship awards may be restricted from immediate families of financial donors.

## Application Process

1. Candidates must complete the scholarship application form.
2. Candidates must submit a copy of their most recent academic transcript.
3. Three third party letters of reference should follow the enclosed guidelines and must be forwarded directly to the Alberta Golf Association Foundation Scholarship Committee.
4. Candidates must enclose a letter outlining their future objectives and reasons for being considered a scholarship award candidate.
5. All application materials must be returned to the Alberta Golf Association Foundation Scholarship Committee; Golf House, #22, 11410 27 Street S.E. Calgary, Alberta T2Z 3R6.

## Application Deadline

Completed Scholarship applications and accompanying information must be delivered to Alberta Golf no later than July 31.

## Payment of Awards

Awards will be directed to the selected recipient or school upon submission of proof of registration.
